VII. Management

- Treat them like kids on a field trip. Count them going out. Count them coming in.
- Always lock them up. They *will* disappear.
- Two hands. Keep them above the desk.
- Face-down for attention.
- Assigning a particular iPod to a particular student is a good idea.
- Never, ever, ever... ..ever, share the iTunes account password.
- Find a student helper!

Tips:

- The apps are all wiggling! What does that mean?
 - This happens when you press and hold an app. It allows you to move apps around or delete them. Just press the HOME button to make them freeze.
- An app is missing. What do I do?
 - Not a big deal. Just re-sync it!
- My wireless doesn't work. What gives?
 - If it looks like every site is getting blocked, check in Settings to make sure you're connected to PCS_Secure. Never use PCS_In. It won't work. If you are on Secure and are still getting blocked, you may need to re-authenticate. Just launch Safari and try to open a different web site.
